

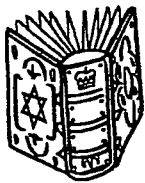

Sunday On-going Classes:

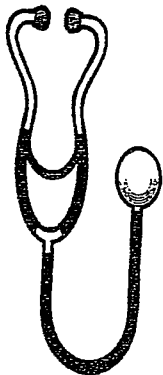


- 9:00-10:00-Psalms 101-explore the beauty and poetry of our psalms with other TBI members, meets every Sunday school is in session

- 11:00-12:00-Adult B'nai Mitzvah Class with Rabbi Michael Weinberg, every Sunday when School is in session.



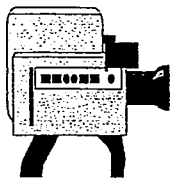
